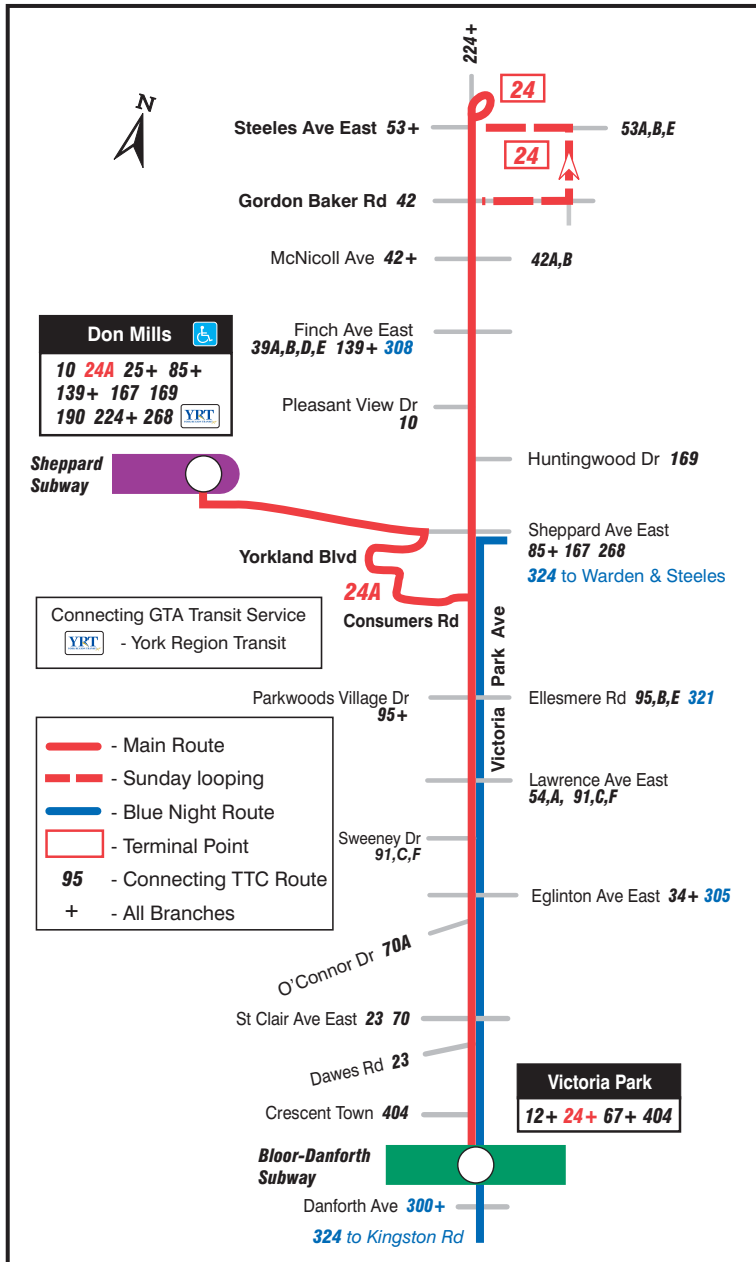

Service reliability improvement - Consumers Road

Additional time will be added to the schedules of the 24A (Victoria Park Stn-Don Mills Stn via Consumers Road) branch during the morning and afternoon peak periods and midday from Monday to Friday, to reduce the effects of increased traffic congestion and to improve the reliability of the service. There will be no change to service levels, but specific trip times will change.

Request Stop Program

Allows women travelling alone on buses between 9:00 p.m. - 5:00 a.m. to ask the driver to let them get off the bus at locations between the regular TTC stops.

TTC's Blue Night Network

Service is provided from approximately 1:30 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. on a basic network of routes throughout Toronto, at stops with reflective blue bands. Service is provided every 30 minutes or better.
